

**Subject:** Notification of Field Investigations in Plumper Bay January 31 – Feb 4, 2022

The Department of National Defence (DND) is planning to undertake a field program to further investigate the environmental condition of Plumper Bay. The field program will involve collecting sediment from beaches in two areas during the afternoon and evening low tides in Plumper Bay.

**Location:** Plumper Bay (yellow polygons)

**Dates:** 31 January to 4 February 2022

**Approximate Time on Site:** 3 pm to 11pm

**Details:** All locations will be accessed via a 34' aluminum landing craft vessel equipped with lights. Crews will access the beach at each location to collect sediment using shovels and a portable hammer drill which may produce noise at levels that could be heard by community members.

**Safety Measures:** Measures will be taken to minimize potential disturbance to community members during the field work including:

- measures to reduce noise generated during the work
- noise monitoring during activities which may generate noise
- directing lights away from nearby houses
